

QPSW Relief grants

Applications are currently open for these annual grants, which are available for projects in the UK and overseas. All projects/programmes requesting support should be for peacebuilding or for relief of people who are suffering as a result of natural disasters, climate change, war, conflict or social and economic deprivation, but not for immediate crisis relief.

Each project must have a Britain Yearly Meeting Quaker link (person or group) and the application should arise from the concern of Friends, supported at least by their local meetings.

Projects need not be Quaker led.

Annual grants may be for up to £6,000 per project.

Applications can be for a single year, but grants for two or three years will also be considered, and existing as well as new projects may be supported. The grant may cover all or only part of the total funding required.

If a beneficiary has previously received a grant for two or three consecutive years, there must be an interval of at least one year before they can be considered for another grant, and a new project proposal would need to be substantially different from any previous application.
